### Press Release

The Central Board of Secondary Education is pleased to declare the result of the first National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test-UG, 2013. Among the registered candidates, a total of 717127 candidates were eligible to appear in the NEET-UG, 2013, out of which 658040 candidates appeared in the test and 366317 candidates have qualified the test. The test was conducted at 1251 examination centres located in 85 cities all over India and abroad.

Details of the candidates qualified the test on the basis of the minimum qualifying criteria of NEET-UG, 2013 are as follows:-

The cut off score for qualifying in NEET-UG is also provided in the Result Sheet.

The Result of NEET-UG, 2013 has been declared on the basis of the qualifying criteria prescribed by the Medical Council of India and Dental Council of India. The qualified candidates have to further complete the formalities with the respective Counselling Authorities, such as, DGHS, Medical Education Directorates of States, AFMC, Institutions and Universities, etc. for admission to MBBS/BDS Courses.

The details and schedule of counselling would be available on the websites of MOHFW, Medical Education Directorates of States, AFMC, Institutions and Universities concerned. The counselling would be conducted by the respective Counselling Authorities through personal appearance/online counselling subject to rules and norms for admission in Medical Colleges/Dental Colleges under their ambit. Candidates are advised to be in touch with the respective Counselling Authorities and Institutions concerned for further details.
