The examination will be held in the third week of December and it is open for the students of classes III to XII who would be divided in four groups viz Group A (Classes III, IV, V), Group B (Group VI, VII, VII), Group C (IX, X) and Group D (XI, XII). The competition is bilingual in Hindi and English languages and is objective type, Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) examination. Students of each group will be given a different set of 50 multiple choice questions to solve along with a subjective question to answer in 100 words on a given topic .

The winners of this competition are given attractive cash prizes, trophies, medals while certificates of participation are given to all the participants. Some selected schools are also given 'Green School Award' which is conferred in a Prize Distribution Function.
