CORRIGENDUM


SUB: Revised Exemptions/Concessions extended to Differently Abled Candidates for Class X & XII Examinations conducted by the CBSE and Standard Operating Procedure

CBSE has consolidated the exemptions/concessions being extended to Persons with Benchmark Disabilities vide Circular No. CBSE/COORD/112233/2018 dated 26th September, 2018. Also, the schedule for making request to avail facilities/exemptions has been consolidated vide Notification No. CBSE/Coord/DS/2018 dated 5.11.2018. To streamline the process of extending exemptions/concessions the revised summary of exemptions is given in **Annexure-III** at circular dated 26th September, 2018 which will be applicable for seeking exemptions.

Annexure-III has further been updated by giving disability code and after synchronizing with PWD Act 2016.

Other modalities remain the same as mentioned in Circular No. CBSE/COORD/112233/2018 dated 26th September, 2018 and Notification No. CBSE/Coord/DS/2018 dated 5.11.2018.

All the schools are requested to read and understand circular dated 26th September, 2018 & 5th November, 2018 and the current circular to adhere to the guidelines/instructions.
