



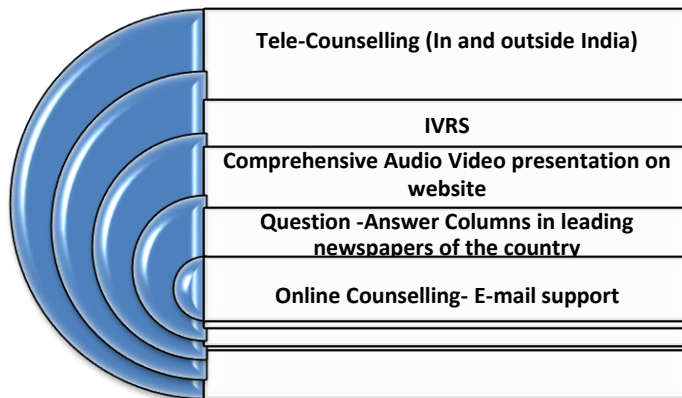
CBSE to Begin Annual Pre Exam Psychological Counselling

The Psychological counselling will begin from the 01st of February, at the time of preparation and during the examinations up to 04th April, 2019 to help students overcome exam related anxiety.

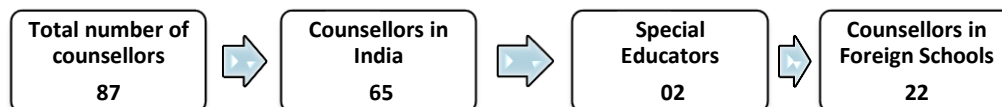
Multiple modes of CBSE Counselling 2019
