SUBMISSION OF EXAMINATION FORMS BY PRIVATE STUDENTS FOR CLASS-X EXAMINATIONS - 2023

The Central Board of Secondary Education will hold the examinations for following categories of private students in the month of February/March/April – 2023 along with the Board's Annual Examinations 2023:

S. N.	Category
1.	Students of the session 2021-22 who have been declared ESSENTIAL REPEAT in the result of 2022 examination.
2.	Students of the session 2021-22 who have been placed in COMPARTMENT in Board's Main Examinations 2022 if not declared Pass in the 1st chance.
3.	Students of the session 2021-22 who have been placed in COMPARTMENT in 1 st chance Compartment Examination-2022.
4.	Students who have been declared FAIL/ESSENTIAL REPEAT in 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021
5.	Passed out students of 2022 who wish to appear for Improving their Performance in one or more subjects
6.	Passed out students of 2021 and 2022 who wish to appear in an Additional Subject
7.	Women Students who are bonafide residents of the National Capital Territory of Delhi (NCT of Delhi) .
8.	Candidates With Special Needs who are bonafide residents of the National Capital Territory of Delhi (NCT of Delhi) on producing reasonable evidence of having difficulty to attend normal institutions.

Accordingly, the online submission of form by the students placed in the above categories for the examination scheduled to be held in 2023 will be starting from **17.09.2022**



Features of Online system of registration are:

- a) All forms and fees will only be accepted in online mode **strictly** as per the schedules given.
- b) No application shall be accepted in offline mode.
- c) No application shall be accepted after last date on any ground.
- d) No application shall be accepted without fee.
- e) Fees for all activities will be accepted only through online payments mode i.e., Net Banking/Debit/Credit Card (both National/ International).
- f) No fee shall be accepted in offline mode i.e., DD/ Postal Order /Money order/ cheque etc.
- g) Board is extending several exemptions/concessions to students with disabilities as defined in the RPWD ACT-2018. These exemptions/concessions have been circulated vide circular dated 12/04/2019. The circular is available on the link:

- h) For seeking exemptions/concessions, students will be required to upload a copy of the Medical Certificate (Disability Certificate)
- i) While submitting application form, details in respect of students who have appeared in the Board's Examinations 2022 will be auto-generated in the online system and will be visible to the applicants.
- j) Students of 2021 and before will need to submit their details like Roll No. and Year of Passing etc. in the online application/portal.
- k) If a candidate makes wrong entries in his/her application form or gives false statement or produces false document, his/her form shall be rejected, fee paid shall be forfeited and such candidates shall be considered to have used unfair practices and will be dealt accordingly.
- l) **The examination centre will be allotted as per the choice of city filled in the online form.**
- m) **It has been observed that some candidates complete the online entry of application but do not remit the fee. If fee is not remitted by last date, his/her application will be rejected without any notice.**

- n) No excuse that Cyber-café etc. has committed the mistake will be accepted and application will be dealt as per rules. Candidates are advised to fill their form themselves.
- o) Mere submission of form and payment of fee will not confer a right on the candidate for appearing in the examination. His/her eligibility will depend upon the fulfilment of the eligibility conditions prescribed by the Board.
- p) **The submission of forms for examination has been made fully online. Accordingly, it is informed that hard copy of the form is not required to be sent to CBSE except following category of students:**
1. **Women students who are bonafide resident of the National Capital Territory of Delhi and have attained the age for appearing in Class X.**
 2. **Physically Handicapped students who are bonafide resident of the National Capital Territory of Delhi and have attained the age for appearing in Class X on producing reasonable evidence of having difficulty to attend normal institutions.**

ELIGIBILITY TO APPLY AS PRIVATE STUDENTS FOR SECONDARY SCHOOL EXAMINATION (CLASS X)

CATEGORY	ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA
FULL SUBJECTS (5/6/7 SUBJECTS)	(A) Students whose result has been declared as ESSENTIAL REPEAT at the Secondary Examination (Class X) 2022. OR
	(B) Students whose result has been declared as FAIL/ESSENTIAL REPEAT at the Secondary School Examination (Class X), in the years 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020 or 2021. OR
	(C) Students who had completed regular course of studies and had been allotted Roll No. for appearing at Secondary Examination but could not appear for the Class X examination due to medical reasons except shortage of attendance at the Secondary Examination (Class X) 2022. OR
	(D) Students who have been placed in Compartment in two subjects may opt for appearing in 5/6/7 subjects in which he/she had appeared in Board's Examinations 2022. SUCH CANDIDATE SHOULD SELECT HIS/HER CATEGORY AS ESSENTIAL REPEAT WHILE APPLYING ONLINE. OR
	(E) Physically Handicapped students who are bonafide residents of the National Capital Territory of Delhi (NCT of Delhi) on producing reasonable evidence of having difficulty to attend normal institutions in the subjects not involving practical training/examination. Medical certificate in this regard be sent to the concerned Regional Office. Students applying under this category cannot take subjects involving practical component OR
	(F) Women candidate who is a bonafide resident of the National Capital Territory of Delhi and has attained the age for appearing in Class X:
	(i) if would have appeared through a school as a regular candidate; OR
(ii) one year after passing Class IX and two years after passing Class VIII as a regular candidate AND	
(iii) satisfy the following additional conditions: -	
(a) that she has privately pursued the prescribed course of study under proper guidance; and	
(b) that she is unable to join a Secondary School affiliated to the Board or there are such other reasons compelling her to appear at the examination as a private candidate.	
(iv) Women candidate applying under this category cannot take subjects involving practical component. However, they may opt for Home Science with Practical.	
COMPARTMENT	Students whose result has been declared as COMPARTMENT in Board's Examinations 2022 and Compartment Examinations 2022 can apply only in the subject in which he/she has been placed in Compartment. Such students should select his/her category as COMPARTMENT while applying online.

IMPROVEMENT OF PERFORMANCE	<p>Only such students who have passed the examination of the Board in 2022 can apply for improving his/her performance in one or more subjects provided he/she should have appeared in the same subjects in the examination held in 2022.</p> <p>However, a student who has passed an examination of the Board under Vocational Scheme may reappear for improvement of performance in the main examination in the succeeding year or the following year provided they have not pursued higher studies in the meantime.</p>
ADDITIONAL SUBJECT	<p>Students who have passed Board's Examination can apply for an Additional subject from the list of subjects enclosed, within 02 years of passing the examination (students who have passed in 2021 or 2022 is eligible to apply). However, students cannot apply for a subject involving practical work. Students is allowed to take subjects having project component.</p>
NOTE # 1	<p>Students applying for Improvement of Performance cannot apply for appearing in Additional Subject and vice-versa.</p>
NOTE # 2	<p>Only those students who have been declared PASS can apply for Improvement of Performance or Additional Subjects subject to fulfilment of other conditions.</p>

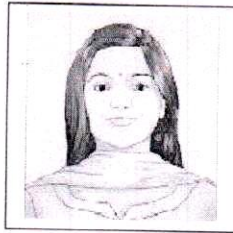
GENERAL INFORMATION	
1.	<p>ONE APPLICATION FORM</p> <p>The process of submission of application forms is online, therefore, the students can fill only one application form. In case the student has submitted one application he/she will not be allowed to apply again under any other category. The students may therefore select their category and other details carefully.</p>
2.	<p>SYLLABUS</p> <p>Students will be examined only in the Subjects and Syllabus as prescribed for the year of examination. Candidate must go through the eligibility and pass criteria as well as current curriculum and scheme of studies available on the CBSE website link www.cbseacademic.in/curriculum.html carefully before filling the form.</p>
3.	<p>SUBJECTS WHICH HAVE LABORATORY PRACTICE INVOLVED</p> <p>Private candidates cannot take subjects which have laboratory practice involved, however, Women Private Students (Delhi only) can offer Home Science with Practical. Similarly, Candidates with visual impairment (Blindness) (Delhi only) have the option of offering any one of the codes of Music Subject i.e., 031 or 032 or 033 or 034 or 035 or 36.</p>
4.	<p>CHOOSING SUBJECTS</p> <p>Applicant will be able to apply only for subjects which are auto-generated in the system.</p>
5.	<p>CARE WHILE INDICATING THE SUBJECT CODE AGAINST LANGUAGES</p> <p>Care should be taken for indicating the subject code against languages as there is more than one type of courses. For language, medium code is not required.</p>
6.	<p>NEW ROLL NUMBER</p> <p>Fresh (New) Roll Number will be allotted by the Board for the candidates appearing in 2023. In no case the candidates will be allowed to appear with the previous year's Roll Number.</p>
7.	<p>EXAMINATION CENTRE</p> <p>Examination centre once allotted will be final and no request for change of examination centre will be considered. Examination centre will be allotted by the Board based on the city choice filled in examination form by the student.</p>
8.	<p>CORRECT POSTAL ADDRESS</p> <p>Applicant will be required to provide correct postal address.</p>
9.	<p>PAYMENT OF FEE</p> <p>Payment should be made from either your own account/debit/credit card or any of your parent/sibling's account/debit/credit card so that in the event of any refund, the same reaches you and no one else.</p>
10.	<p>SIZE OF JPG FILES OF PHOTO AND SIGNATURE</p> <p>Applicant needs to upload scanned jpg files of their photo and signature not exceeding 40 KB in size as per procedure given in Annexure 3.</p>
11.	<p>ISSUANCE OF MARKSHEET & CERTIFICATE</p> <p>(a) Original mark-sheet and certificate of previous year examination is not to be surrendered to the CBSE.</p> <p>(b) Marksheet & Certificate of 2023 examination will be issued after declaration of result to all the candidates who will appear for the examination, 2023.</p> <p>(c) Candidate appearing for Improvement of Performance or for Additional Subject(s) will be issued a separate fresh Marksheet cum Certificate reflecting only the marks obtained in the said examination.</p>

	(d)	Consolidated marksheet & certificate will be issued only to such candidate who will appear for 2 nd chance Compartment and will pass in the said Compartment Examination in 2023. Consolidated marksheet & certificate will contain marks obtained in the subjects passed in the previous examination held in Main/Compartment 2022 as also the marks obtained in the subject appeared for at the 2 nd chance Compartment examination.	
	(e)	Board issues mark sheet cum passing certificate indicating marks obtained in each subject separately. No aggregate score/percentage is mentioned by the Board. Candidates who take 6/7 subjects and pass in all 6/7 subjects, the percentage is to be calculated according to the norms of college/institution in which the candidate is seeking admission.

	(a)	Admit Card	Eligible candidate will be able to download their Admit Card from the CBSE website www.cbse.nic.in
	(b)	Original Marksheet & Certificate	Original Marksheet & Certificate will be sent by the concerned Regional Office to the residential address given by the applicant in the application form, by Speed Post.
	For candidates who will be appearing in examinations from centres in Delhi.		
	(c)	Admit Card	Eligible candidate will be able to download their Admit Card from the CBSE website www.cbse.nic.in .
	(d)	Original Marksheet & Certificate	Original Marksheet & Certificate will be sent by Regional Office, Delhi to the examination centre where the candidate had appeared for the examination. Candidate can collect the Marksheet & Certificate from the examination centre on production of original admit card. Examination centre will retain original document for one year from the month of declaration of result and thereafter left out documents will be returned to Regional Office, Delhi East or Delhi West, as the case may be.

(A)	Fail /Essential Repeat/ Compartment / Improvement of Performance
(i)	Details of Candidate's Name, Father's/Guardian's name, Mother's name etc. will be auto-generated in the online system in respect of those who have appeared in the Board's examination held in 2022. Students of 2021 examination (or before) will need to fill in the details in the online application form.
(ii)	Fill-in correct combination of your Roll number, School number and Centre number (as given in your marksheet) of Board Examination, wherever available.
(iii)	In case wrong details are filled, the application will not be processed and error message will be displayed.
(iv)	The practical/internal assessment/project etc marks scored by the student will be carried forward or pro rata marks will be given or practical examination will be conducted again as per applicable provisions of bye-laws.
(B)	For those appearing under Category(ies) – Fresh Female/Physically Handicapped (Delhi)
(i)	Subjects should be chosen as per the drop-down list.
(ii)	Marks obtained in Theory examination will be converted to be out of 100 Marks through computer programming in the subjects having Internal Assessment component. The marks will be added in theory marks.
(C)	For those appearing under Category – Additional Subject
(i)	Any one subject from the list of subjects in Annexure 5 , which was not taken earlier
(ii)	Marks obtained in Theory examination will be converted to be out of 100 Marks through computer programming in the subjects having Internal Assessment component. Marks will be added in theory marks.

STEPS FOR SCANNING AND UPLOADING OF PHOTOGRAPHS

PHOTO TYPE



- Photo should be in full colour and of high quality to avoid any visible pixels.
- Photo must be taken in the last 6 months.
- Head should be positioned directly facing camera, centred and compose 80% of image.
Photo should capture from slightly above top of hair to middle of chest.
- Have a natural expression - smiling is fine.
- Subject (candidate) is in clear focus and distinguishable from the background
- Solid colour backgrounds are best.
- Eyes must be open and looking at the camera. Glasses must not be tinted unless worn daily for medical purposes.
- The individual's full face must be clearly visible
