| 6. | Does CBSE provide grace marks?                     | The Board examinations are to test the knowledge of the students gained during the academic year. If a student has secured 33% marks, student is declared pass. If any student is not able to achieve 33% marks and miss out by 01 marks or so, decision may be taken to award the grace mark(s).  |
