#### Introduction:

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), an autonomous organization under Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, is one of the premier Boards of the country. The main objectives of the Board are to serve the educational Institutions effectively and to be responsive to the educational needs of the students.

The Board has approx. 13,300 schools affiliated with it including 150 schools in twenty one countries abroad.

The prime focus of the Board is on

## 2.5 Opening of Technical bids:

- 1. Bids will be opened in presence of bidder's representatives (if they are present, else it will be opened in presence of the other representatives, officials present). The bids will be opened at the address mentioned above.
- 2. CBSE will open all bids as per schedule mentioned in "Bidding Schedule" above. If all documents mentioned in each part of proposal are not found, then Bid may be summarily rejected. The bidder's representative willing to attend the opening of the bids shall bring authorization letter. The bidder's representative shall sign attendance register also.
- 3. The bidder's name, technical solutions given by bidder, bid prices and presence or absence of requisite bid security and such other details, as CBSE at its discretion may consider appropriate, will be announced at the time of corresponding openings.
  - 4. The bids submitted after due date and time shall not be considered for further evaluation, irrespective of the circumstances. CBSE reserves the right to postpone or cancel a schedule of bid opening at any time.
  - 5. The date and time for opening of financial bids shall be informed later to those who will be found technically suitable.

#### **3. Eligibility Conditions :** (Please provide documentary proof for following with technical bid)

- 1. Adequate experience of providing satisfactory services in the relevant fields including rental services to educational institutions or other related organizations (Supported by work order and client satisfaction report).
- 2. The agency should have its own infrastructure i.e. Hardware and manpower team for providing service in the relevant field. (Supported by purchase orders and inventories etc).
- 3. The Minimum Annual turnover should be 50 lakhs or more during financial year 2011-12.(Supported by Financial Statements, Balance Sheet).

9. The Secretary, CBSE reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason thereof. The Board reserves the right to allot the job to one or more firm quoting the lowest rates or to more than one firm on the lowest rates received by the Board.

## 4. Scope of Work:

#### 4.1 For Mobile/Cell phone/ Electronic Device Jammers during entrance examination :

To supply and install required Number of Mobile/ Cell phone/ Electronic Device Jammers to block voice and image transmissions incoming and outgoing from/to mobile/cell/camera phones/ in the Examination Centers on the day of examination.

#### Note

- a) The agency will have to ensure that sufficient no. of Jammers are supplied and installed to block cell phone/blue tooth services in the center i.e. CDMA/ GSM/ 3G/ 4G/ Spy Camera/ Wi-Fi/ Bluetooth
- b) The agency will have to ensure that the jammers supplied and installed works with or without electric supply for the entire duration of the Exam in the Centers without any technical fault/power failure.
- c) The agency will have to ensure to block the required band width/ signals
- d) The agency will have to install industry standard Mobile/ Cell Phone/ other Electronic devices including Spy Camera Jammers in the Centre

## 4.2 For Capturing of Finger Prints/ Photo during entrance examination:

- 1. To supply required hardware, software and manpower for capturing of Finger Prints (two fingers to be specified by the Board) and Photograph of examinees during entrance examination at each centre on the day of examination. Capturing of Finger Prints and Photographs is to be done at the time of writing the examination by the examinees i.e. while the candidate is sitting in Examination Room/Hall on the seat.
- 2. To supply images of finger prints and photographs on DVDs/ Hard Disc as per requirement of the Board. Cost of DVDs shall be borne by the agency and Hard Disc shall be supplied by the Board.

#### Note

- a) The agency will have to ensure that sufficient no. of devices are supplied to scan all candidates in the center during the course of the Examination.
- b) The agency will have to ensure that the camera/devices used should take clear crisp photograph of the face / finger prints.
- c) The agency will have to ensure that the scanned image is stored against the Roll No. of the candidate and used for matching later.
- d) Agency shall have to ensure 100% matching of Roll No., photograph, and finger prints of the candidate. And also ensure that the photographs of the candidates and finger prints are not mis-identified and wrongly attributed. In case of mismatch, it shall be treated as mistake.
- e) The agency will have to ensure that the photographs of the candidates and finger prints are as per industry standard and recoverable on industry standard software.

#### 6. Terms and Conditions:

- 2. The agency shall have to execute an agreement on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 10/- if considered for allotment of the work.
- 3. The agency to which the work is allotted will be required to deposit 10 percent of the total likely amount payable to it for the work as a security in the form of a Bank Guarantee.

#### 4. Penalty and Deductions:

- a) The time schedule has to be strictly adhered as the examination related work is highly time bound. In case of failure at the Centre on the part of the agency or on part of equipments failures, it shall be liable to pay penalty equivalent to amount payable for that centre to the CBSE and Board shall not make any payment for that Centre.
- b) Any variation/ mismatch in the photograph, and finger prints of the candidate **or** the photographs of the candidates and finger prints are not as per industry standard and recoverable on industry standard software shall be treated as error. In case of error, the following deduction shall be applicable:

- c) In case the agency is not able to execute the job to the entire satisfaction of the CBSE, the Bank Guarantee submitted by the firm shall be liable to be forfeited in whole or part as per decision of the Chairman of the Board, which shall be final.
- 5. The Board reserves the right to reject any or all the tender without assigning any reasons.
- 6. The payment will be made after satisfactory completion of work only and no advance payment shall be made.
- 7. The agency should have adequate infrastructure and deploy required manpower for the successful completion of the assignment as per the above mentioned scope of work.
